- Residence for the School Sisters of St. Francis purchased
- 1966** ▼ Archbishop Bergan dedicated Mary Our Queen Church
- 1968** ▲ 8 additional classrooms added
- 1971** ▲ Gymnasium constructed
- 1985** ▲ Priests' rectory and parish center built at 3535 S. 119th St.

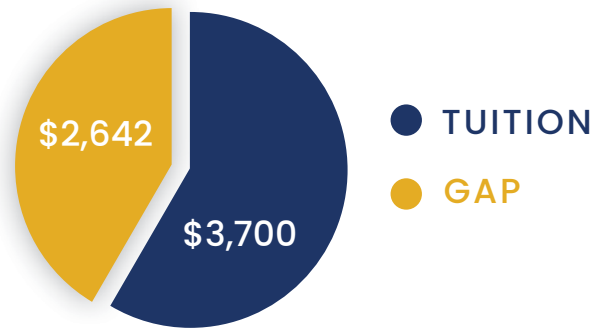
Bridge the Gap.

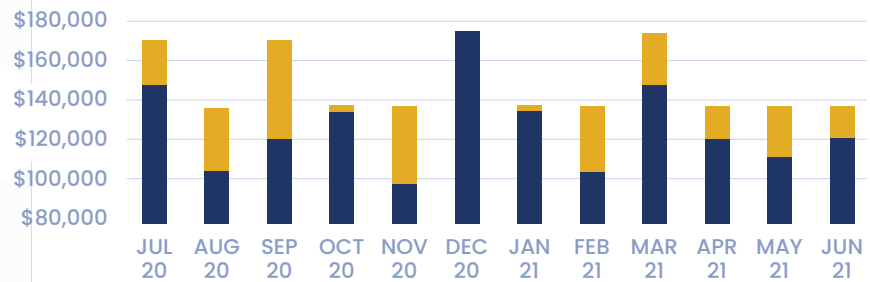

Budgeted vs. Actual

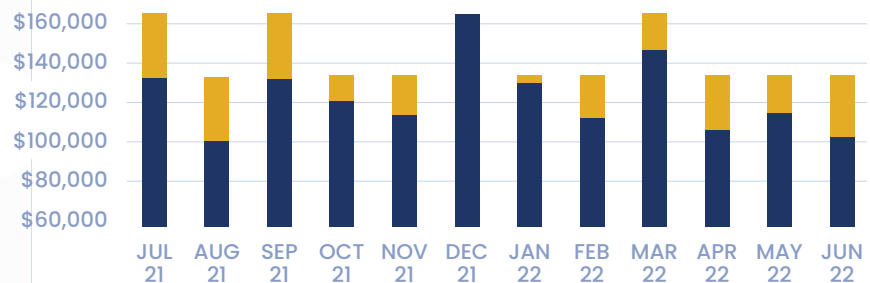

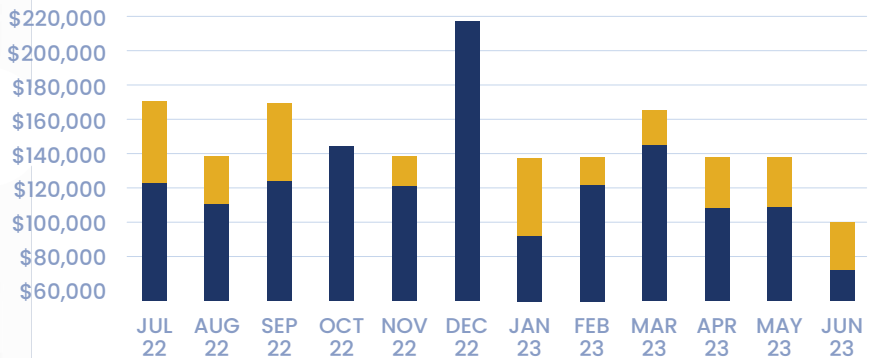
